Dear Parent / Carers

As Year 11 pupils near the end of their time at Blessed Trinity, I would like to draw your attention to procedures for examinations and our other end of year activities.

All pupils have been issued with a booklet '**Examination Information for Parents 2016**' and it details all our expectations regarding the upcoming GCSEs. The booklet is also available via our website.

All Year 11 pupils will finish after their Leavers' Mass on Thursday 9 June. Until this date, we will continue to run a full timetable for all students. The Mass itself will be at midday, after the pupils have sat their final Maths GCSE that morning. Pupils will be dismissed from school at approximately 1.30 pm on that afternoon.

After this date, pupils must still wear full school uniform for all subsequent exams or revision sessions they attend. With the exception of their exams, when pupils can make their way straight to the Spirit of Sport, on all other occasions pupils must sign in and out at reception.

May I take this opportunity to thank you for your support throughout the year and ask that you continue to encourage your child to revise regularly and thoroughly during the coming weeks. For most students it is better to revise for short periods of time with regular breaks without interference from TV, music and phones! A quiet room with no distractions is best.

I look forward to August when I hope we will be distributing another excellent set of exam results. These will be available on Thursday 25 August 2016 and can be collected from 9.30 am. If your child is unable to collect them, they may do one of the following:
