Further to my letter of Friday 13th March 2020, I am writing to you with an update.

Following consultation with other Headteachers' and my Senior Leadership Team, I have decided to postpone school visits, trips and additional activities up until the Easter holidays. Parents who had purchased tickets for the Bradford Theatre trip will be reimbursed.


We are continuing to follow Department for Education Guidance, which is:

- If the symptoms are serious and cannot be managed at home or persist longer than 7 days, please go to NHS 111 online, or call 111.

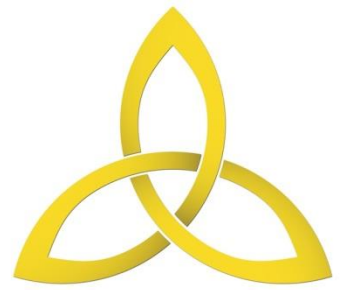
