

Re: Year 11 Spring Revision Programme

Following the completion of the Year 11 Mock Examinations in December and the 'Mock Results Day' on Tuesday 7 January, it seemed the perfect opportunity to update you on our plans to continue supporting your child with our **Year 11 Spring Revision Programme**

• **Year 11 Revision Event Wednesday 22 January 2020**

We are delighted that **Elevate Education** are coming into school on **Wednesday 22 January** to work with Year 11 on revision and study skills. This external company will work with pupils for an hour on Wednesday, during school time. We hope that the session will enable all pupils to take a fresh look at their current approach to revision, and will motivate them to move forward and further improve their current set of grades.

• **English Revision**

The English team continue to run their highly effective revision sessions after school on Mondays. The team also have plans to help pupils further raise their grades, in this key subject, with a range of *'Walking Talking Mocks'* this term.

• **Mathematics Revision**

The Mathematics team have launched an innovative revision programme that runs after school on Tuesdays. Sessions have been built around analysis of each pupil's mock examinations and are designed to target those topics where pupils lost valuable marks. Pupils will work with different pupils and different teachers each week depending upon their individual strengths and weaknesses.

• **Science Revision**

The Science team continue to run their after school revision sessions on Thursdays. In addition, they have launched their popular Saturday School, where pupils are invited to come into school to revise Science in Saturday morning classes.

• **RE Revision**

The RE team continue to run their highly effective revision sessions after school on Fridays. Pupils, whose performance in the December Mock was disappointing, are busy using these sessions to prepare for a resit exam.

Other Subjects and Home Revision

A revision timetable, showing the full range of after school and before school sessions is available on the school website.

Additionally, it is essential that pupils are completing revision at home. We encourage them to make use of the '**Topic of the Week**' information to structure their weekly study plans. This information is sent out to you each week, appears on the school website and is put onto Show My Homework.

As you can see, there is an abundance of school support for your child at this important time in their school career. We know that you will encourage them to get fully involved in the school revision programme and we look forward to a productive term with pupils working with us to fulfil their potential.
